


HOW TO USE UK NATIONAL STATISTICS WEBSITE

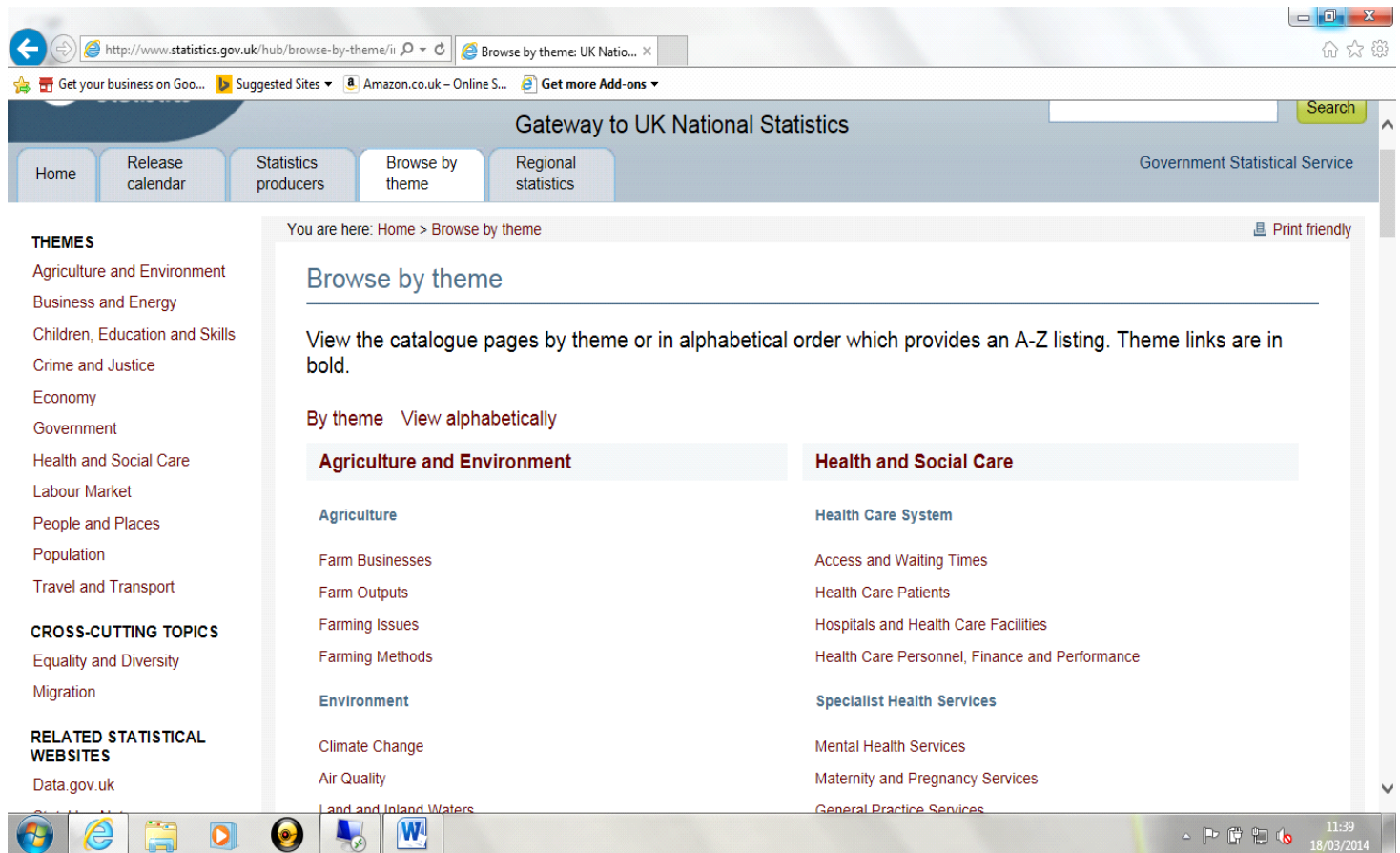

1. When directed to the UK National Statistics home page you will need to select an appropriate tab from the selections running across the top section of the page to refine your search. The two tabs frequently used will be ‘Browse by theme’ and ‘Regional statistics’.



2. Once you have selected a tab you'll be able to select a theme relevant to your research. Each link is catalogued by specific core themes e.g. Agriculture and Environment, Health and Social Care, Business and Energy etc.



3. Once you have selected a category relevant to your research you will be displayed with numerous publication topics relative to the category chosen. Once you have found a publication topic that might be of interest to you, you need to select the “All Editions” link under the title to find specific publication reports covering the topic chosen.



4. You will now see a list of past and future editions of the publication topic selected. Once you have found a report that is of relevance to your research you will need to click on the title of the report and this will then redirect you to another source where you will be presented with the findings of the report.
